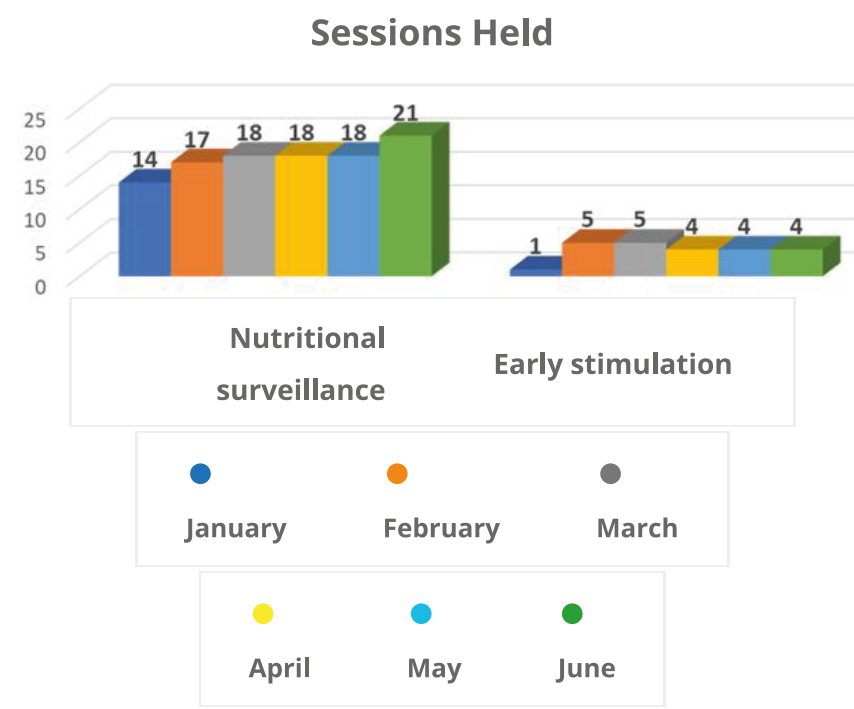


Comprehensive care for early childhood

With your support at the beginning of life, 106 nutritional monitoring sessions and 23 early stimulation sessions have been carried out, providing a total of 2,058 services to children aged 0 to 5 years in 18 communities during 2022.

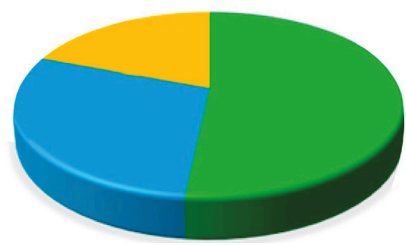


83 community volunteers participated in comprehensive early childhood care activities. 56 volunteers received training.

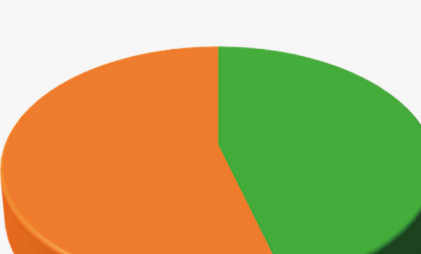
Nutritional surveillance Attention according to sex I Semester 2022

Early stimulation Attention according to sex I Semester 2022



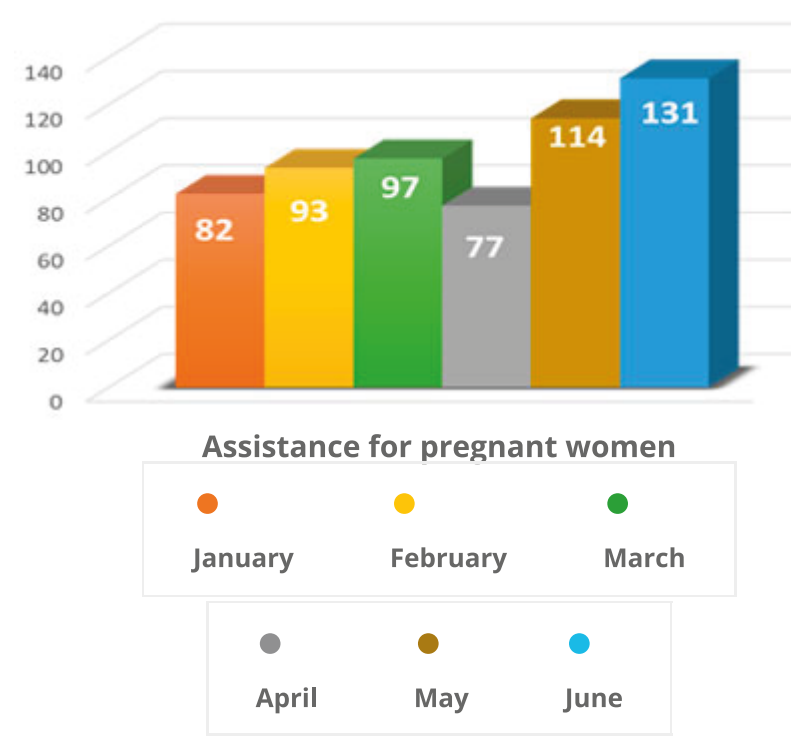
100,530 Nutributter sachets were distributed in 1229 deliveries to boys and girls from 6 months to 2 years old. This supplement complements essential nutrients for healthy growth and development.



Safe Motherhood

With your support for safe motherhood, 38 educational sessions have been held with pregnant women's clubs in 18 communities.

7% of pregnant women who attend are teenagers.

47,160 sachets of the Enov Mum supplement were distributed to 546 pregnant and lactating women.

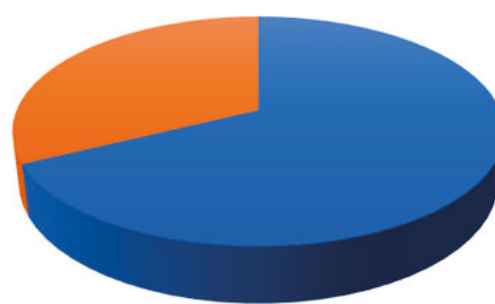
43 postpartum women were identified and given a safe maternity basket containing baby clothing and hygiene products.



Healthy Housing

In the first half of 2022, 15 families living in poverty already have new homes with the conditions to provide healthy spaces.

People trained in healthy housing



34 people participated in training sessions for the management of community drinking water systems.

266 volunteers from 18 communities participated in campaigns to prevent vector-borne diseases: dengue, Zika and chikungunya, giving educational talks, cleaning and eliminating breeding sites, applying larvicides and fumigation.

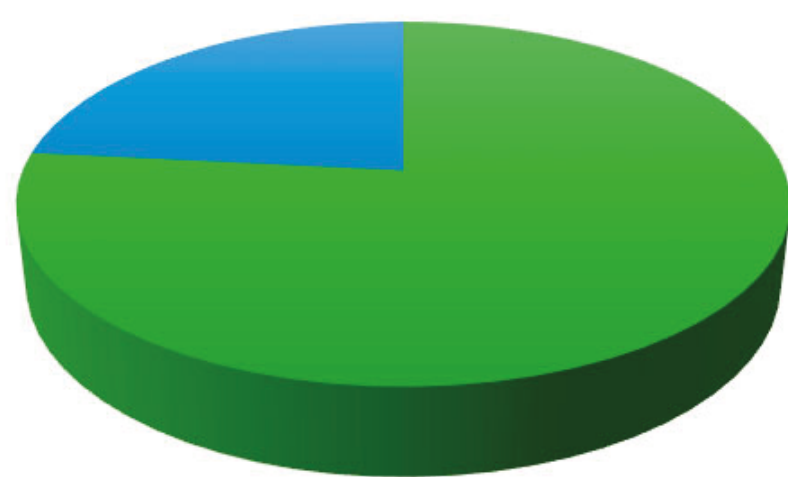

Food Safety

This semester, family food production has been supported through the yard plan methodology that includes family gardens and poultry raising, as well as corn production.



124 people trained in patio planning



77% of the people who benefit from technical assistance for the backyard plan are women, who incorporate actions to improve family food production.



Five Star Schools Program

More than 950 students and 37 teachers from the same number of first to third grade classrooms have benefited from the provision of teaching materials to support the educational interaction process carried out in 14 educational centers.



Construction of a sanitary module at the Adolfo López Canales School, benefits 87 students.



361 girls and boys and 21 teachers from 14 pre-primary education centers received biosecurity material for a safe return to school classrooms preventing Covid-19.
