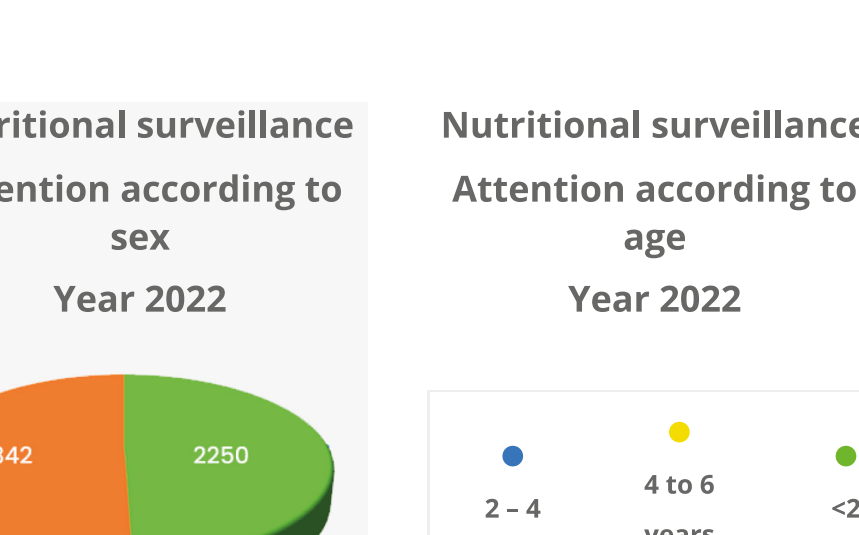


Comprehensive care for early childhood – 2022

With your support at the beginning of life, 209 nutritional monitoring sessions and 48 early stimulation sessions were carried out, providing a total of 4,592 services to children aged 0 to 5 years in 18 communities during 2022.

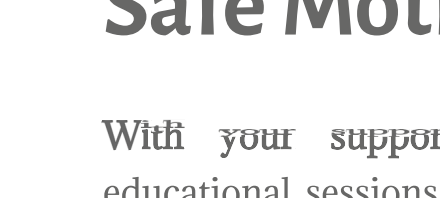


90 community volunteers participated in comprehensive early childhood care activities. Training was provided to 203 volunteers and members of health committees.

Year 2022



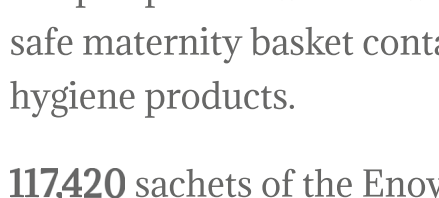
Nutritional surveillance

Year 2022

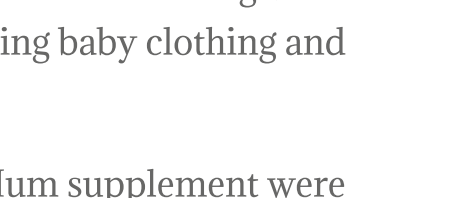


Early stimulation

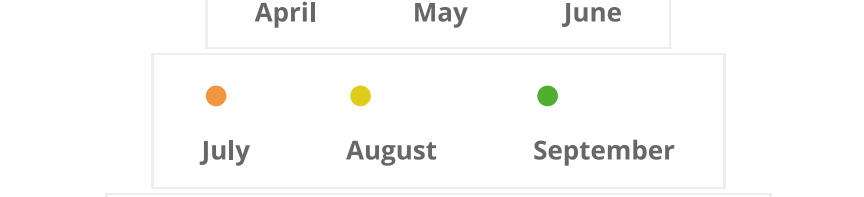
197,400 Nutributter sachets were distributed in 1,763 deliveries to children aged 6 months to 2 years; 2,595 kg of MannaPack Rice fortified food was delivered to children aged 6 months to 5 years.



Safe Motherhood

With your support for safe motherhood, 71 educational sessions have been held with pregnant women's clubs in 18 communities.

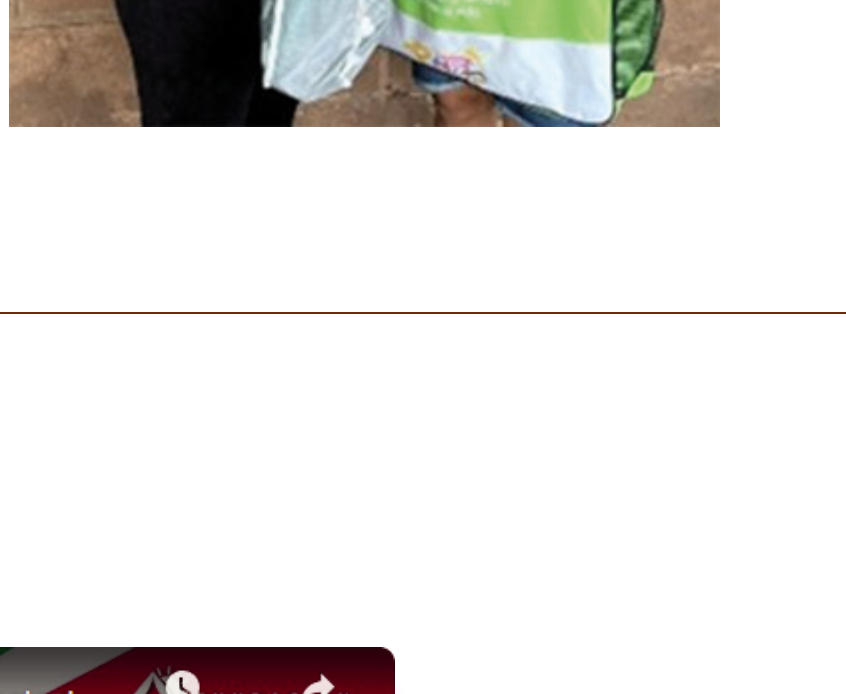
Pregnant women participate in safe maternity club



130 postpartum women were identified and given a safe maternity basket containing baby clothing and hygiene products.

117,420 sachets of the Enov Mum supplement were distributed to 1,329 pregnant and lactating women.

9% of pregnant women who attend are teenagers.

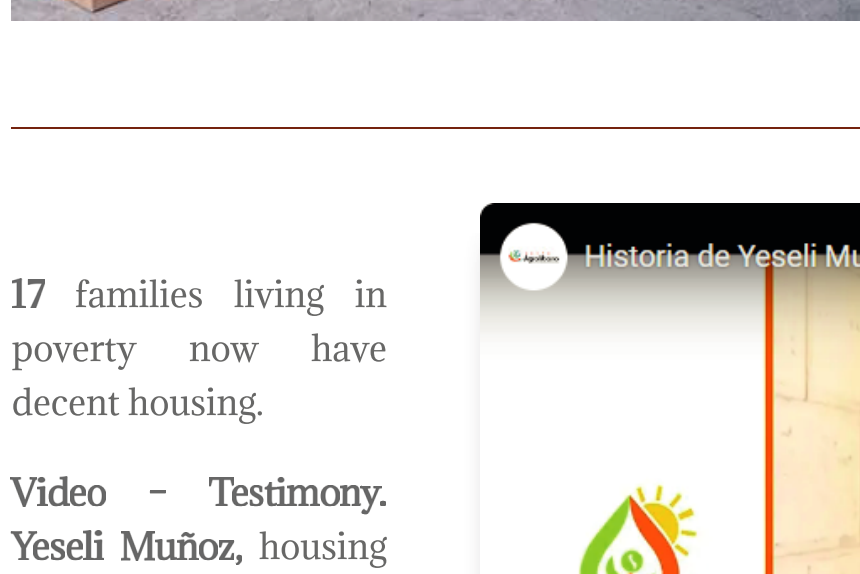

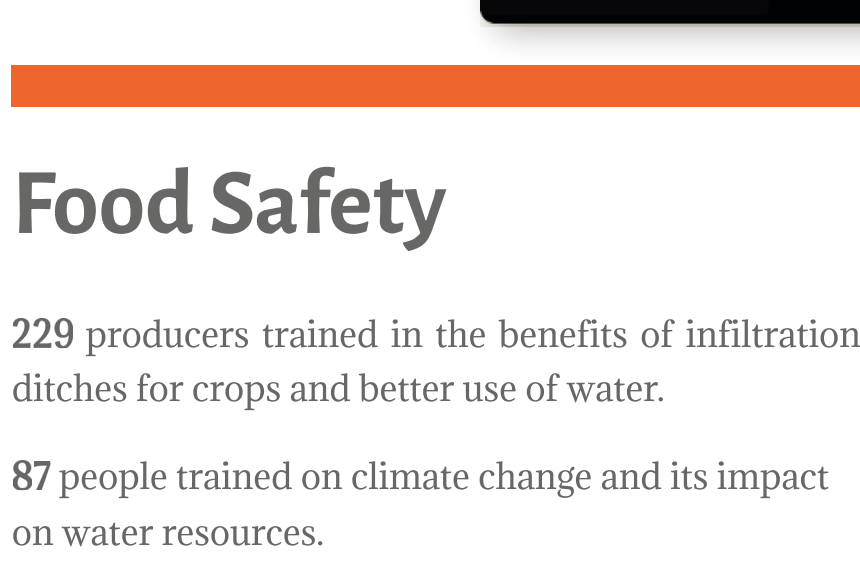


Healthy Housing

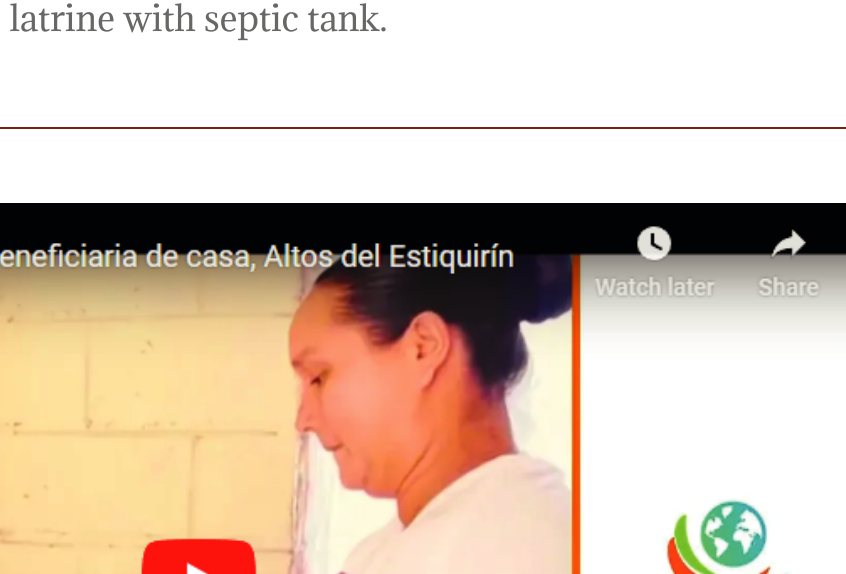
10 Community Health Committees organized, made up of 103 people who have been trained to contribute to family health.



55 families receive water purifying filters to improve the quality of drinking water.



82 families in vulnerable conditions benefit from an eco-stove, decreasing the risk of diseases caused by smoke and reducing firewood consumption to protect the environment.



14 families with children aged 0 to 5 years benefit from concrete floors, providing better hygienic conditions for child development.

8 families reduce poverty-related deprivation and improve basic sanitation conditions with a washable latrine with septic tank.

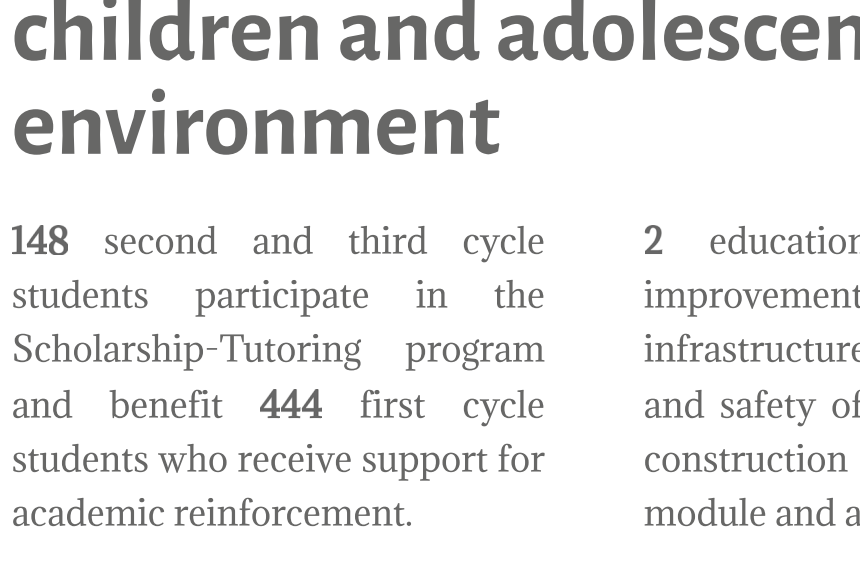

Food Safety

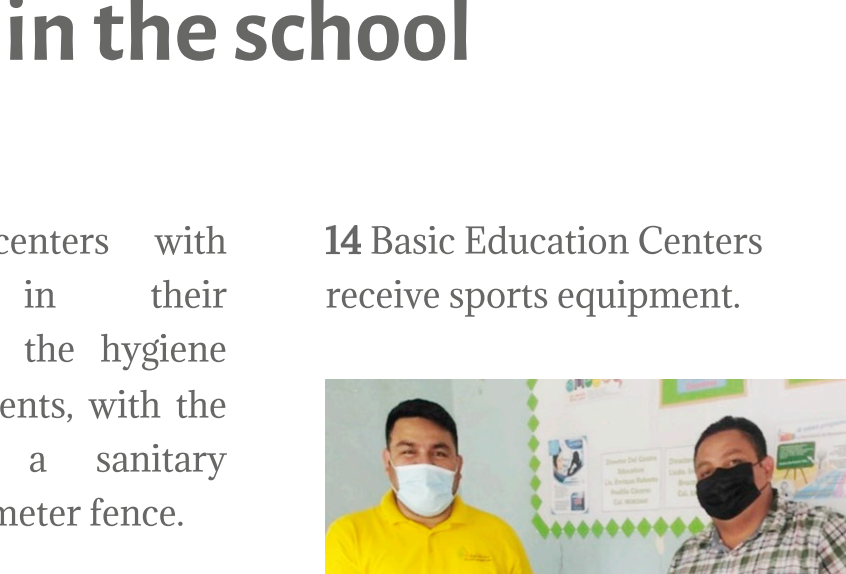
229 producers trained in the benefits of infiltration ditches for crops and better use of water.

87 people trained on climate change and its impact on water resources.



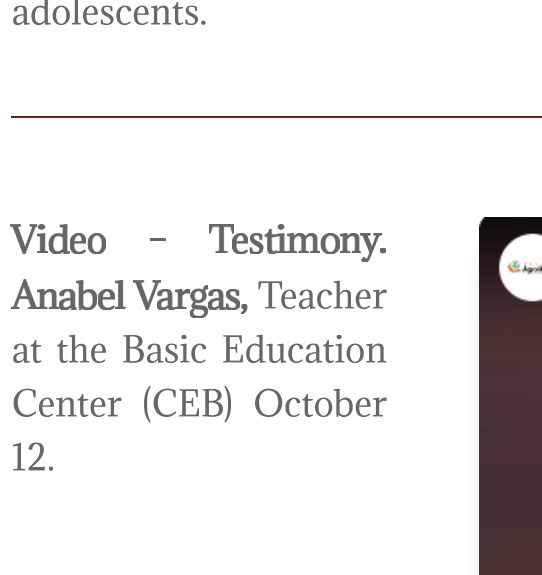
145 people trained on pests, diseases and integrated crop management.

Support for the comprehensive development of children and adolescents in the school environment

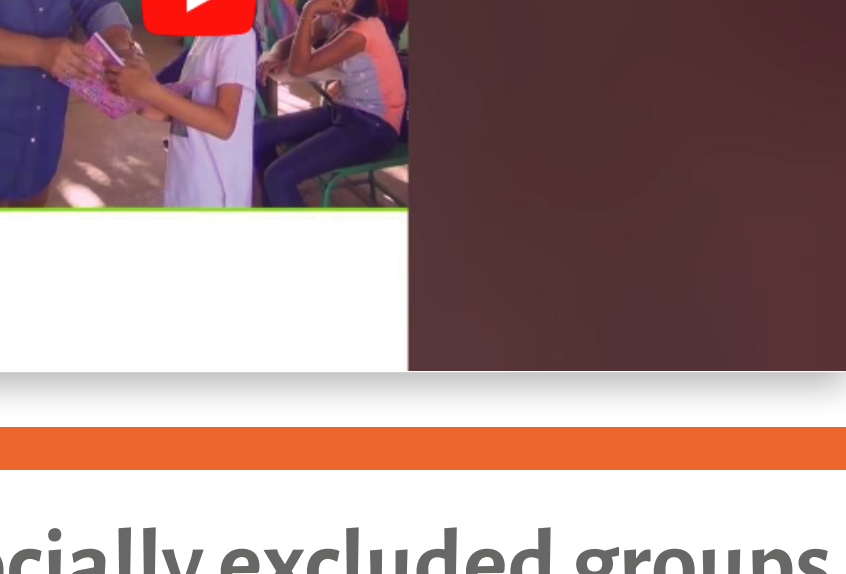
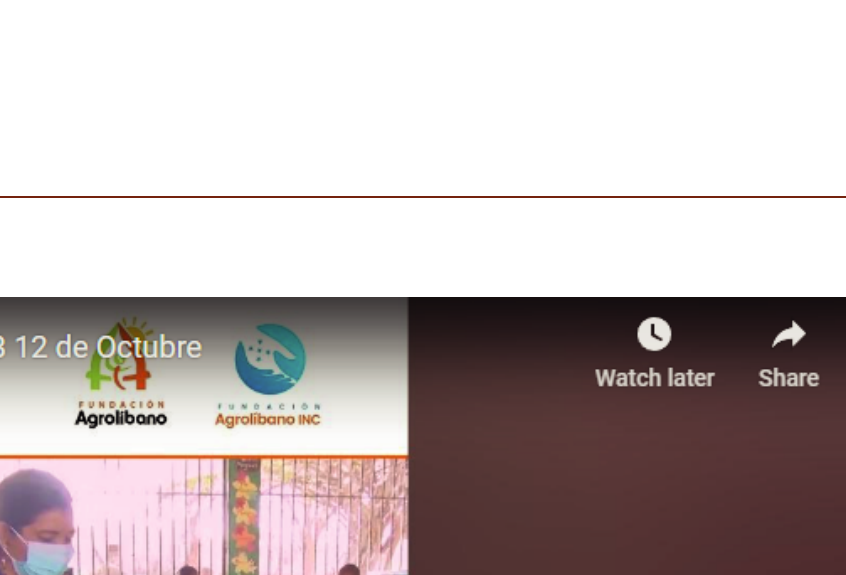
148 second and third cycle students participate in the Scholarship-Tutoring program and benefit 444 first cycle students who receive support for academic reinforcement.



217 third cycle students (7th, 8th and 9th grade) participate in 8 talks on sexual health and reproductive health for the prevention of pregnancy in adolescents.

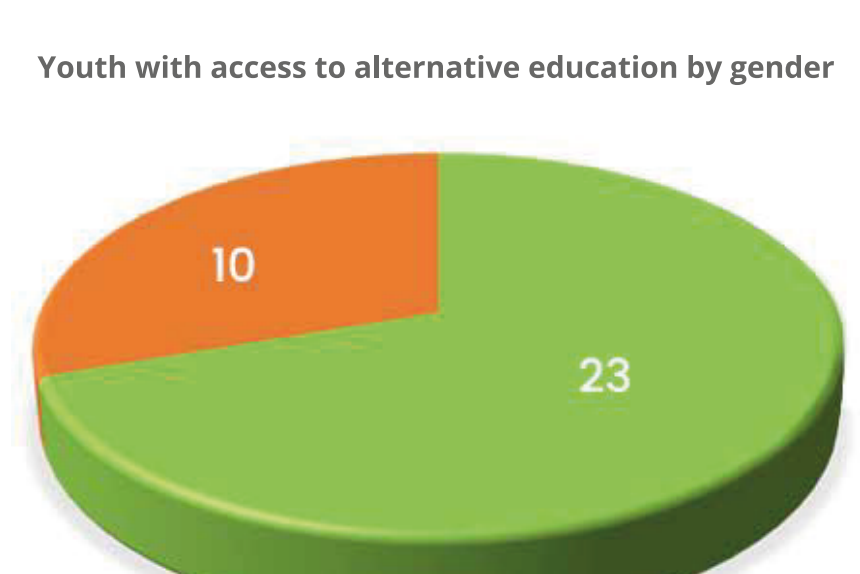
2 educational centers with improvements in their infrastructure, for the hygiene and safety of students, with the construction of a sanitary module and a perimeter fence.

4 alternative education centers implemented, 2 in basic education and 2 in secondary education, providing access to 294 families in 3 communities.

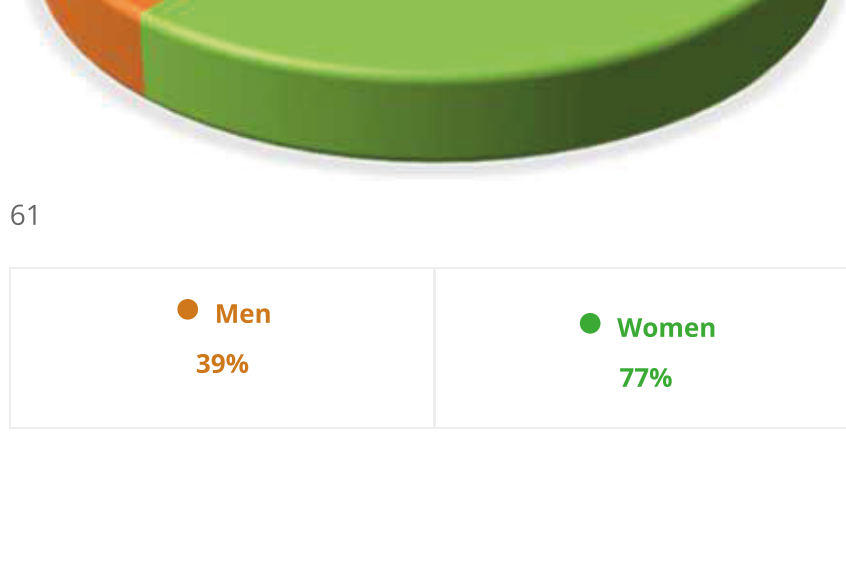


15 young people completed the school year in the 3rd cycle of basic education and 18 young people in secondary education.

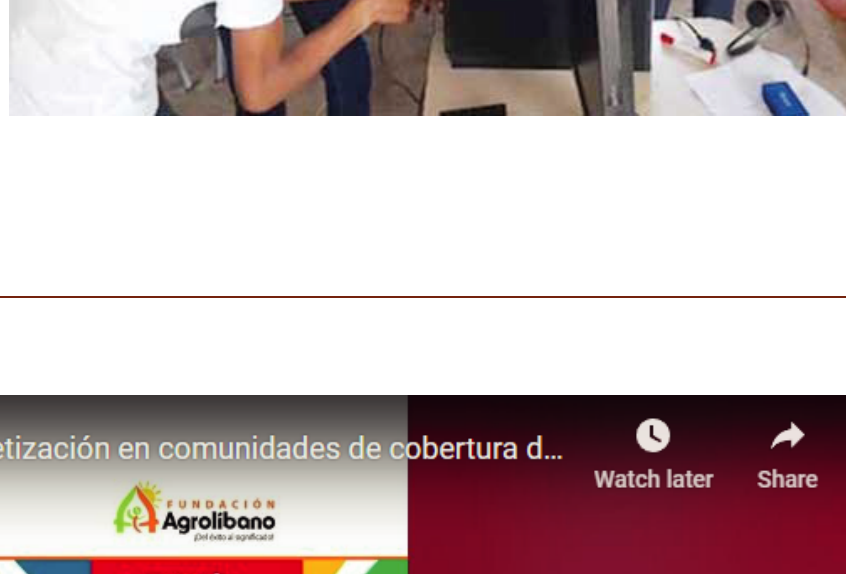
Youth with access to alternative education by gender



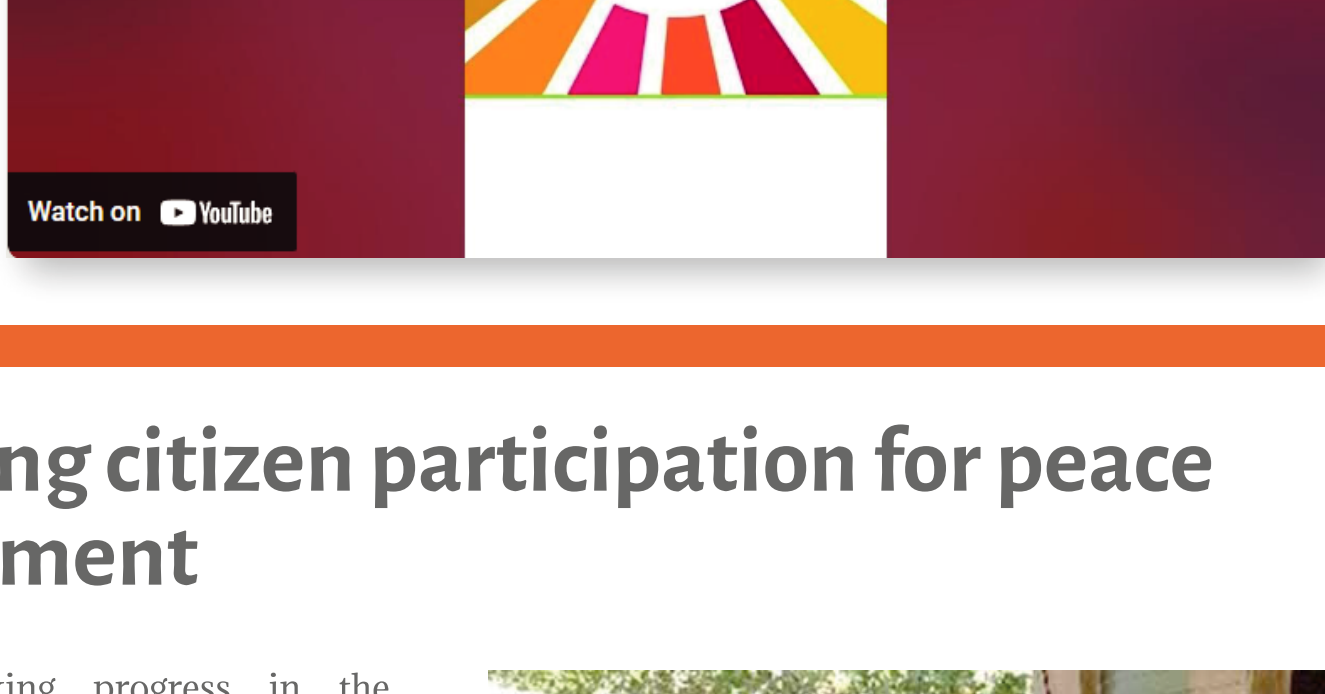
31 people became literate in 3 communities, 94% achieved basic reading-writing and arithmetic skills.

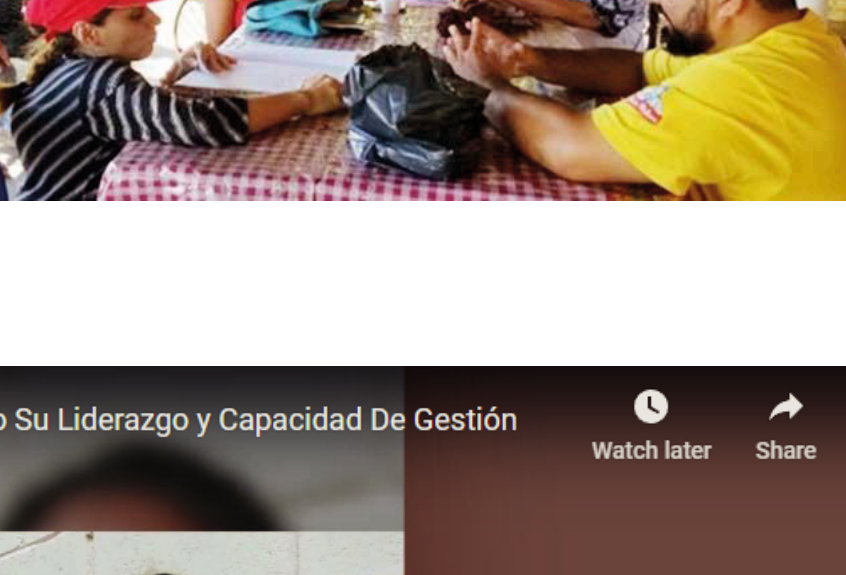
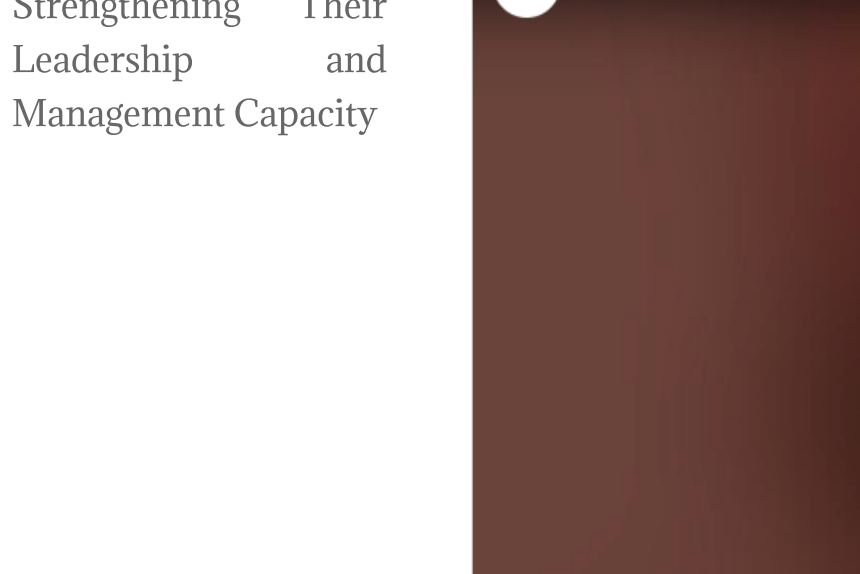


Strengthening citizen participation for peace and development

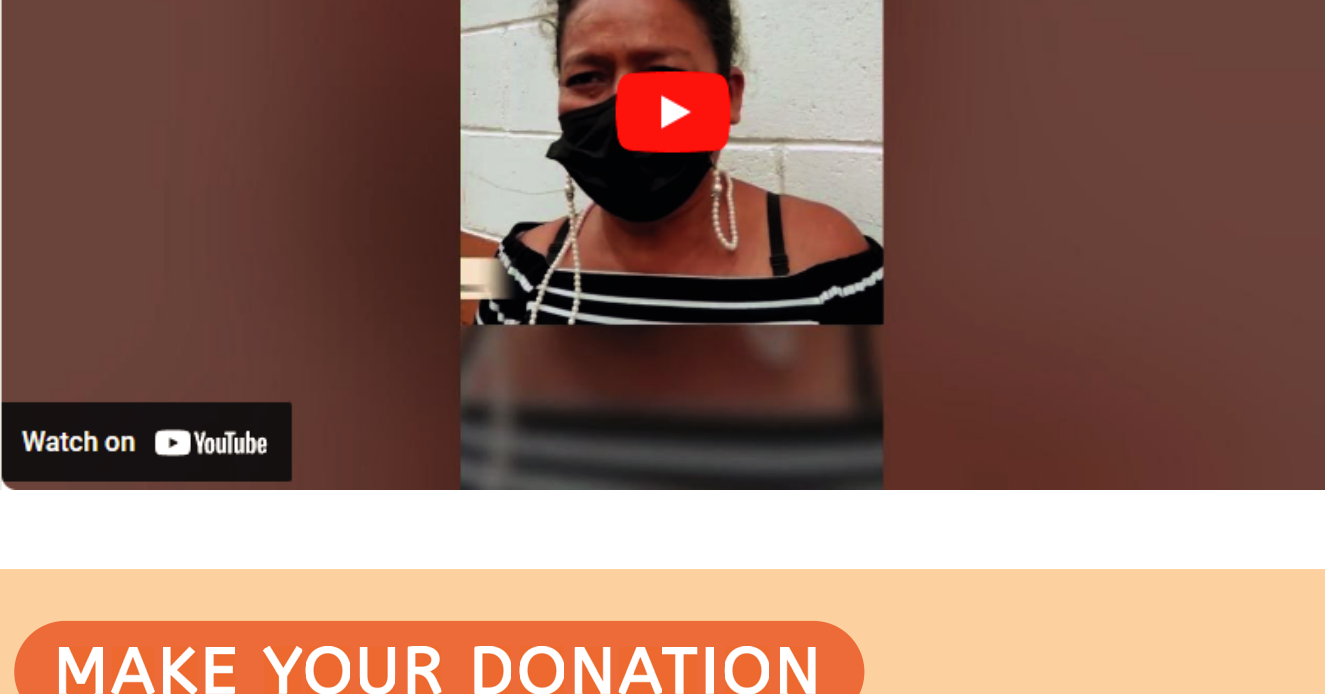
7 communities are making progress in the construction and implementation of their Comprehensive Development Plans.
